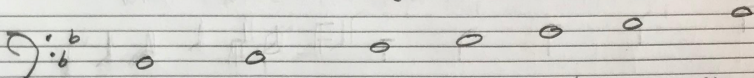


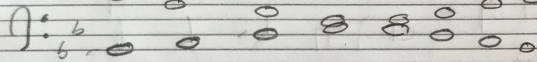
Scales are like the DNA of music

They are the building blocks for any music. To play well, one must know their scales.

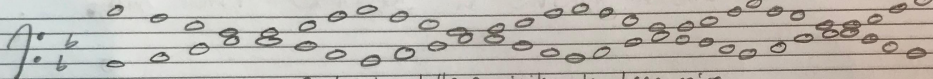
Here is a B-flat major scale written in bass clef.



when writing the same scale over itself, a curious form emerges



And when extended, the structure becomes even more familiar

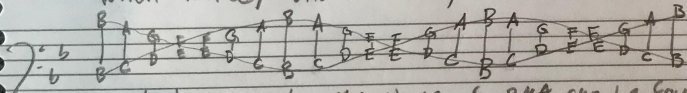


notes are represented by letters, similar to base pairs
